



**REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES OF THE

PUBLIC PROPERTY, COMMISSIONER STOKES

No report was given. However, Superintendent Helm informed the Council that 3 pumps at the wastewater treatment plant are in need of repairs. One pump will need bearings replaced, and two other pumps will need to be rebuilt. Each repair may be as high as \$2,000 to \$2,500. Also, the water plant is in the process of being painted by the public works employees. They are hopeful to have it completed in the next few weeks.
