

**REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES OF THE
CITY OF NEOGA
HELD IN THE CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS, MUNICIPAL BUILDING

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Wayne Modglin. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Those present were: Commissioners Hartke, Lindley, Mayor Modglin, and City Treasurer Diana Foor. Darrell Cox was also in attendance.

MINUTES

Marty Hartke made a motion to approve the regular and executive session minutes from February 24th as presented, and it was seconded by Larry Lindley. Ayes, Commissioner Hartke, Lindley, and Mayor Modglin. Nays, none. Motion carried 3-0.

PUBLIC AFFAIRS, MAYOR MODGLIN

DARRELL COX

Mayor Modglin introduced Darrell Cox who is running for State Representative of the 110th District. Mr. Cox told the Council about his ideas for fixing the pension and answered questions that the council had.

ECIVIS

City Treasurer Foor explained that she and City Clerk Evans recently had a conference call with a representative from eCIVIS. This company offers grant management software to government agencies. Mayor Modglin would like to get more information on the program before making a decision. It was tabled until the next meeting.

NEOGA DAYS LIQUOR LICENSE

Commissioner Hartke informed the council that the Neoga Days committee would like to apply for a special event liquor license for the annual Neoga Days celebration again this year. He stated that everything would be the same as last year, and the Park Board has already approved having the beer stand at the celebration. Commissioner Lindley made the motion to approve the liquor license pending an acceptable application. It was seconded by Commissioner Hartke. Ayes, Commissioner Lindley, Hartke, and Mayor Modglin. Nays, none. Motion carried 3-0.

TAXING DISTRICT REPORTS

Commissioner Lindley said he missed the library meeting, but will try to make it to the next one.

Commissioner Hartke confirmed that the Fire District received a grant for turnout gear.

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CCDC REPORT

Mayor Modglin reported that he attended the monthly CCDC meeting at Toledo. At that meeting Modglin suggested CCDC needs to inform the municipalities what they are doing for the communities.

MAPPING REPORT

Foor updated the council on the fast approaching dinner/dance scheduled for March 29th, and the fish fry fundraiser scheduled for April 4th. The council also saw the Veterans' Memorial model. Commissioner Hartke suggested that the model be taken to the local banks so it can be viewed by more people.
