



**REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES OF THE  
CITY OF NEOGA

**CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Pro-Tem Groves. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Those present were: Commissioners Lindley, Kepp, Mayor Pro-Tem Groves, and City Clerk Evans. Commissioner Hartke and Mayor Modglin were absent. Others present were City Treasurer Diana Foor, and Police Chief Julius.

**MINUTES**

Commissioner Kepp made a motion to approve the regular session minutes from May 29, 2012 as presented. Commissioner Lindley seconded the motion. Ayes, Commissioner Kepp, Lindley, and Mayor Pro-Tem Groves. Nays, none. Motion carried 3-0.

**PUBLIC AFFAIRS, MAYOR MODGLIN**

POLICE TOWING FEES

Neoga Chief of Police Jon Julius presented to the Council a proposed increase in towing charges as follows:

- Any offense requiring a tow not covered below - \$100.
- Driving while license suspended - \$150.
- Driving while license revoked - \$200.
- Driving under the influence / zero tolerance - \$250.
- Any drug related offenses - \$300.
- Second or subsequent offense to any of the above - \$500.

After reviewing the proposed changes, Commissioner Kepp made a motion to accept the increase in towing charges. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lindley. Ayes, Commissioner Kepp, Lindley and Mayor Pro-Tem Groves. Nays, none. Motion carried. 3-0.

NEOGA POLICE POLICY AND PROCEDURE MANUAL

After reviewing the proposed policy and procedure manual, Mayor Pro-Tem Groves recommended tabling the vote until everyone was in attendance.

After reviewing the ordinance, it was the consensus of the Council to table the ordinance until a later date.

NCIS DONATION

Mayor Pro-Tem Groves asked the council to donate \$50 to assist in the shipping of the banners. After little discussion, Commissioner Kepp made a motion to donate the \$50. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lindley. Ayes, Commissioner Kepp, Lindley, and Mayor Pro-Tem Groves. Nays, none. Motion carried. 3-0.

WATER TOWER FENCE

City Clerk Evans presented a quote for a new chain link fence around the newly painted water tower. The bid came in at \$5,929. After little discussion, Commissioner Kepp made a motion to accept the bid from Coles County Fence Company in the amount of \$5,929. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lindley. Ayes, Commissioner Kepp, Lindley, and Mayor Pro-Tem Groves. Nays, none. Motion carried. 3-0.
