CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Modglin explained that the public hearing meeting was being held to hear comments on the Plan of Operation and Governance for Municipal Opt-Out Electricity Aggregation for the City of Neoga. Mr. Modglin apologized for not having someone from Coles County Regional Planning or Good Energy attending the meeting but assured those in attendance that if they had any questions not were not answered, City Clerk Evans would get the answers to them the next day. Mr. Hoelscher asked how the electric aggregation would effect the residents who participate in an all electric rate with AmerenCIPS. Mayor Modglin said that as per the plan, anyone who currently participates in the space-heat, Power Smart Pricing, Hourly Supply Service, Real Time Pricing, RES Service and/or net metering programs, will not be affected by the electric aggregation.
