

NEOGA CITYWIDE CLEANUP SATURDAY, JUNE 22nd, 2019

The City of Neoga is planning their annual citywide cleanup on Saturday, June 22nd. The cleanup will be held at the parking lot in the 600 block of Chestnut Avenue. Those who live in the corporate limits will be allowed to drop off items at the designated area from 8-noon on June 22nd with proof of residency (driver's license and utility bill). Chestnut Avenue will be one way between 6th & 7th Street during the cleanup. All vehicles will enter off of 7th Street into the parking lot at the south entrance and will exit back onto 7th Street at the north entrance by the railroad tracks. This cleanup will have THREE stages to drop off items:

- 1. Electronics (computers, key boards, cell phones, televisions, etc.)
\$5 FEE PER EACH ELECTRONIC ITEM
- 2. Paper shredding. Papers or books are accepted and can have paper clips, staples, and binder clips. No 3-ring binders will be accepted.
- 3. Dumpsters for the remaining items. Items that will not be accepted include: construction materials and roofing, car parts, tires, paint, fluorescent bulbs, landscape waste, hazardous waste, and liquid waste.

If you have any questions you can contact the municipal building at 895-3237. Again, this is a CITY cleanup, and you must show proof of residency by bringing a driver's license and a water or utility bill before you can drop anything off.
